PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: Federal and State of Georgia Fair Housing Laws prohibit discrimination in housing based on race, color, religion, sex, disability, family status, or national origin; and

WHEREAS: Annually, in the month of April, the City of Hinesville will commemorate the anniversary of the passage of Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, the Federal Fair Housing Law; and

WHEREAS: The City of Hinesville, Georgia, supports the efforts of local agencies, non-profits, the private sector, and individuals in ensuring compliance with the Federal Fair Housing Law; and

WHEREAS: The City of Hinesville, Georgia affirms the right of all people to choose where they wish to live and can afford without encountering discrimination; and

WHEREAS: The City of Hinesville certifies that it will engage in activities to affirmatively further fair housing; and

WHEREAS: The month of April has been designated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development as National Fair Housing Month.

Now, Therefore, I, Mayor James Thomas, Jr., Mayor of the City of Hinesville, do hereby proclaim the month of April as:

“FAIR HOUSING MONTH”

in Hinesville, Georgia, and call upon all citizens of the City of Hinesville, Georgia, to participate in ceremonies and activities supporting the Federal Fair Housing Law and the celebration of diversity and equal opportunity throughout the City.
