Sewage Spill on Monday, April 29, 2019

HINESVILLE, Ga. (April 29, 2019) – On Monday, April 29, City of Hinesville Public Works / ESG Operations, Inc. reported a sewage spill of approximately 219,000 gallons at 730 E General Stewart way.

The spill was caused when excavation equipment struck a sewage line.

The line has been repaired, service restored and the area has been cleaned. The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) and Health Department have been notified.
