Telecom Issues in Georgia's Cities: Small Cells

GMA will host a series of Regional Workshops to address the deployment of small cell antennas, discuss GMA's model Master Right of Way (ROW) agreement, and inform city officials about legislative and regulatory proposals that could preempt local authority to regulate the ROW. Greg Fender, GMA's principal consultant with the GMA Telecommunications and Right of Way Management Program (TRM) will also discuss compensation for use of ROW and other key points to consider when negotiating with small cell companies. The workshop will also include a discussion of compensation for water tank towers, land leases and fiber in the ROW.
