Hinesville Police Department Make Arrest in Murder Investigation

HINESVILLE, Ga. (March 22, 2019) – At approximately 12:24 p.m. on Friday, March 8, officer(s) of the Hinesville Police Department, along with Hinesville Fire First Responders and Liberty County E.M.S., responded to 719 Robin Hood Drive in reference to an unresponsive child. At the residence, first responders observed the lifeless body of nearly 2 years old, Serenity Belue. H.P.D. detectives responded and a death investigation began with the assistance of the Liberty County Coroner's Office.

On Monday, March 11, an autopsy was performed at the Georgia Bureau of Investigation Crime Lab in Savannah. Results of the autopsy lead to the arrest of Amir Rashawn Camp and Cynthia "Makenzee" Belue Camp for the offense of Malice Murder. The step-father and the mother of the deceased were incarcerated at the Liberty County Jail where their bonds were denied.

The investigation continues and the Hinesville Police Department would ask anyone with information pertaining to this investigation contact the main office at (912)-368-8215.
