2019 City Planning Workshop Wrap-up

HINESVILLE, Ga. (May 6, 2019) – On Friday and Saturday, May 3 and 4, the City of Hinesville conducted its annual off-site workshop to plan for the next year and prioritize initiatives and projects.

Hinesville City Council members submitted a total of 23 topics for discussion amongst themselves and with Hinesville Administrative staff, including the City Manager, Assistant City Manager, City Engineer and City Attorney.

Among those topics discussed were prioritization of infrastructure projects, Liberty Transit, event permitting, on-site consumption, curbside recycling, livestreaming of Council meetings and several City ordinances.

“The offsite workshop provides a setting for council members and City employees to come together and have an open discussion about the issues affecting Hinesville at present and how they will direct the course of our future. Not only that, but the workshop provides a means to develop plans for addressing the topics in a meaningful and methodical way. By the end of it, we have solid plans or a plan to solve problems that we can bring back to our city and put into action.”

Residents will see many of the issues brought up during the workshop on the agenda for the next several council meetings as issues are resolved and solutions put in place.
