City of Hinesville Hours of Operation for Hurricane Dorian

HINESVILLE, Ga. (September 2, 2019) – As of 2 p.m. on Monday, September 2, a mandatory evacuation is still in effect for Liberty County residents east of I-95. A voluntary evacuation has now been issued for the remainder of Liberty County, with an emphasis on low lying and flood prone areas, especially those east of US Hwy 17. This voluntary evacuation does include the City of Hinesville.

City facility and operational hours will be as follows:

Tuesday, September 3: Normal operating hours in effect unless otherwise posted.

Wednesday, September 4: City facilities will be closed and public safety operations will be dedicated to respond to Hurricane Dorian.

Thursday, September 5: City facilities will be closed and public safety operations will be dedicated to respond to Hurricane Dorian.

Friday, September 6: Normal operating hours will resume unless otherwise posted.

PLEASE NOTE: Municipal Court has been cancelled for Wednesday, September 4. The Thursday, September 5 City Council meeting has been cancelled.
