Hurricane Dorian Trash Collection Schedules

HINESVILLE, Ga. (September 3, 2019) – In response to Hurricane Dorian, the City of Hinesville will have a modified trash schedule on Wednesday and Thursday, September 4 and 5. Please see below for service schedule modifications:

- Trash collected on Wednesdays will be collected on Friday (September 6).
- Trash collected on Thursdays will be collected on Saturday (September 7).
- Trash collection on Friday, September 6 will be collected as scheduled.

In addition to the above schedule changes, yard waste collection will be suspended until Monday, September 9.
