## HPD Investigates Shooting Incident on Wildwood Drive

**HINESVILLE, Ga. (September 16, 2019)** – At approximately 2:22 p.m. on Sunday, September 15, officers with the Hinesville Police Department responded to the area of Peggy Sue Street in reference to an anonymous report of shots fired. As officers were in responding, a second complaint came from the residents of 789 Wildwood Drive that someone was shooting at their residence.

Preliminary investigation indicates that a financial transaction was taking place between a resident of the home and the victim, who had arrived shortly before the shooting. The transaction was interrupted by a masked gunman, who began shooting into the residence after attempting to rob another subject who had been sitting outside and then ran into the home for protection.

The victim of the shooting sought treatment at Liberty Regional Medical Center and was later transported to Memorial Health University Hospital in Savannah. The victim's injuries are described as non-life threatening.

The shooting appears to not be a random act and Hinesville Police Department is confident in its preliminary findings in this investigation.
