HDDA Announces Presentation of Hinesville Renaissance & Strategic Vision Plan

HINESVILLE, Ga. (December 19, 2019) – The Hinesville Downtown Development Authority (HDDA) will host the University of Georgia’s Carl Vinson Institute on Tuesday, January 7 for the public presentation of the Hinesville Renaissance and Strategic Vision Plan.

Laying out a variety of opportunities and suggestions for growth, development and enrichment of the urban core of Hinesville, the plan will be presented to the public at 6 p.m. in Council Chambers at Hinesville City Hall.

Over the course of 2019, the HDDA has worked with the Carl Vinson Institute to reimagine all that downtown Hinesville could be. From examining downtown land and streetscapes to suggestions for business ventures, the Strategic Vision Pan for Hinesville has combed through the downtown area to discover ways to highlight and enhance strengths – while also bolstering and eradicating weaknesses.

“The current plan for downtown has reached the end of its lifetime and we have, frankly, outgrown it. Now it’s time to move forward and bring Hinesville into the next stage of growth and development for the benefit of all citizens,” says HDDA Executive Director Karen Durham, “Calling it the Hinesville Renaissance Plan is no mistake. At its core, the word means ‘rebirth’ and that it exactly what the plan accomplishes. This plan is the culmination of months of hard work and dedication for so many people – most of whom know and love Hinesville deeply and want to see it succeed in big ways. I believe that the public will be thrilled when they see what this team has planned for the rebirth and longevity of the city.”

The presentation will begin at 6 p.m. in Council Chambers and feature renderings of plans for streetscapes, storefronts, greenspace and more. Parking will be available for attendees in the municipal parking lot across the street from the Hinesville Police Department.
