HPD Arrests One After Investigation into September Crash

HINESVILLE, Ga. (Jan. 6, 2020) – On Friday, September 27, 2019, the Hinesville Police Department (HPD) Traffic Investigation Unit responded to a 2-vehicle crash on Airport Road at the intersection of Pineridge Way. The crash resulted in serious injuries to the driver of a 2018 Nissan Titan, 24 year old Whitney White of Hinesville; and the driver of a 2017 Dodge Challenger, Brandon Montrell Jones of Hinesville, who is assigned to the Ft. Stewart 92nd Engineer Battalion.

The investigation has been completed into the cause of the crash. Brandon Montrell Jones was arrested on warrants on Monday, Jan. 6, and was booked into the Liberty County Jail. Jones is charged with Serious Injury by a Motor Vehicle (felony), Reckless Driving, Speeding (106 in a 45 mph zone) and other numerous traffic violations. He will appear in court on the charges once a court date is set.
