Temporary In-Office Procedures for Utility Bill Paying

Beginning Friday, March 20 procedures for paying your water bill in-person will change until further notice. The City of Hinesville offices will close to the public and only open for utility bill pay and new account creation from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. in the Water Department.


Here are the steps:

- 1. Please park in either the City Hall parking lot or the Municipal Parking Lot (across the street from the Hinesville Police Department).**
- 2. If you are paying by cash, proceed to the breezeway that fronts E Martin Luther King Drive where staff members will direct you to the line for the building.**
- 3. Only 3 visitors will be allowed into the building at a time in order to minimize exposure to our citizens and staff.**
- 4. Proceed to the open window and conduct your business with our staff members.**
- 5. Upon completion, please exit the building at the direction of staff.**
