### **Liberty Transit Announces Services Changes Due to COVID-19**

**HINESVILLE, Ga. (Apr. 11, 2020)** – Due to COVID-19 and staffing shortages, Liberty Transit is suspending fixed route services on Route 3 until further notice beginning Monday, April 13.

Routes 1 and 2 and paratransit services are still operational and will continue unless otherwise advertised.

Riders are asked to not utilize the Liberty Transit system at this time if they are experiencing flu – like symptoms or believe they have been exposed to COVID-19. Future changes to this temporary suspension of services will be communicated via the Liberty Transit website, social media and press releases.
