## HPD Investigating Traffic Fatality

**HINESVILLE, Ga. (Apr. 20, 2020)** – The Hinesville Police Department (HPD) is currently investigating a traffic fatality which occurred on Elma G. Miles Parkway on Sunday, April 19 at approximately 12:37 a.m.

A driver was traveling southbound on E.G. Miles Parkway when their vehicle struck a pedestrian, who has been identified as Stephen Gerber (46) of Brunswick, Ga. The incident resulted in the death of Mr. Gerber.
