HFD Receives Fire Prevention Grant from FM Global

HINESVILLE, Ga. (Dec. 14, 2020) – The City of Hinesville has received a fire prevention grant totaling \$2,912 from FM Global, one of the world’s largest commercial property insurers.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, FM Global representatives presented the award and a commemorative plaque to the Hinesville Fire Department via mail and electronic notification. The award will be used to assist with fire investigations to help investigators more efficiently assess, investigate and determine the cause of a fire.
