Local Leaders Break Ground on New Park

City and County Leaders work together to bring a new park to local residents

HINESVILLE, Ga. (January 26, 2022) –Leaders from the City of Hinesville and the Liberty County Board of Commissioners broke ground on a new park located on Airport Road.

The park, located on Airport Road, will feature 1/3-mile walking track, dedicated open green space, 2 playgrounds, skate park, a dog park and more. The park will be completed with landscaping and a full irrigation system.

The new park is possible thanks to land donated by Mr. Paul Krebs. Collectively, the new Southside Park project encompass over 4 acres and is centered near multiple residential properties. The park will be funded utilizing City and County SPLOST VI funds.
