Sewage Spill on January 10, 2022

HINESVILLE, Ga. (Jan. 10, 2022) – The City of Hinesville Public Works / ESG Operations, Inc. reported a sewage spill of untreated wastewater from the Hinesville sewer. Approximately 8,850 gallons of wastewater that was discharged from the collection system and entered Peacock Creek, in Hinesville, Liberty, Co GA, near Thornwood Way on Tuesday, January 10th around 9:08 a.m.

The spill was due to a grease blockage in the sewage collection system. The blockage has since been cleared, and the overflow has stopped.

The area of the spill was cleaned and limed following the incident. The Liberty County Health Department, the GA EPD along with the local media have been notified of the spill.
