Water Outages in Flemington

HINESVILLE, Ga. (Feb. 6th, 2022) – The City of Flemington has completed water and sewer installation along SR 38 at Curve. This completion will require at least two water outages. The outages will last between 3 and 4 hours. On **Feb. 6th** and **Feb. 7th**, Simonton Engineering will be locating and testing valves.

The first outage: **ALL RESIDENTS** east and north of **Parkers** will be without water services for **3 to 4 hours**. The second outage: should only effect **Old Sunbury Road** and **ALL RESIDENTS** north along with **Old Hines Road to Gravel Hill S/D**. Tranquil south should not be affected by the second outage. We will post updates on this matter as we receive them.
