Sewage Release on April 11, 2024

HINESVILLE, Ga. (April 11, 2024) – The City of Hinesville Public Works / ESG Operations, Inc. reported a wastewater sewer release at the Fort Stewart Water Pollution Control Plant, located at 629 Hero Road at approximately 0700.

Plant operators responded to the sewer release and all operational equipment was in service. It was determined that due to an excess of 3” of rainfall, the flow was too great and a release of sewer occurred.

The total amount released was estimated at 3,150 gallons and due to the amount of rainfall, the released sewer may have reached State Waters.
