Sewage Release on August 11, 2024

HINESVILLE, Ga. (August 12, 2024) – The City of Hinesville experienced spills from manholes at Rowe Stand Kingston Ln due to rainfall and the residual impact of Tropical Storm Debby, which overwhelmed the sewer collection system.

Approximately 3,390 gallons were released at these points and discharged into the Unnamed Tributary, which leads to Mill Creek. The Health Department and GA EPD have been notified.
