**Sewage Release on August 30, 2025**

**HINESVILLE, Ga. (August 30, 2025)**- Aug. 30, 2025, at approximately 11 a.m., the Fort Stewart Water Pollution Control Plant, located at 629 Hero Road, experienced a wastewater sewer release.

Plant operators responded, and all operational equipment was in service. It was determined that due to an excess of 1.59 inches of rainfall in a short period, flow exceeded capacity and a sewer release occurred. The total amount released was estimated at 1,500 gallons.

Due to the rainfall, the released wastewater may have reached state waters, resulting in a spill.
